At a legal Town Meeting holden at Sudbury on Tuesday September 6th 1870 the Articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows, viz:

Art 1st Chose James Moody Moderator

Art 2^d The Town, by a ballot of Forty-nine to Thirty-eight, Voted not to prohibit the Sale of Ale, Porter, Strong Beer and Lager Beer.

Art 3^d Voted, that the town designate for the location of a school house in the southerly part of the North East district, a lot of land situated in the northwesterly corner of a parcel
