To James L. Willis, a Constable of
the Town of Sudbury in said County. Greeting;

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachu-
setts you are hereby required to notify and warn
the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, qualified
to vote in elections, to meet at the Town Hall, in
said Town, on Tuesday, the eighth day of Nov-
ember next at ten o'clock in the forenoon, to
bring in their votes, for a Governor, Lieutenant
Governor, Secretary, Treasurer and Receiver-
General, Auditor and Attorney General of said
Commonwealth; a Councillor for District Num-
ber Six, a Representative to Congress for District
Number Seven; a County Commissioner,
County Treasurer and a Register of Deeds
for the Southern District for the County
of Middlesex, and a Senator for the Fifth
Middlesex District to the General Court.

The foregoing votes shall all be brought in
on one ballot.

Also, to bring in their votes for a Represen-
tative to the General Court for the Nineteenth
Middlesex District on a separate ballot.

The Polls to be opened at eleven o'clock
A.M. and may be closed at one o'clock P.M.

And you are also required to notify said
inhabitants qualified to vote in town affairs
to meet at said Town Hall at one o'clock in
the afternoon, to act on the following ar-
ticles, viz:

- 1st To choose a Moderator to preside at said Meeting;
- 2^d To see if the town will unite with the town of Stone
to build a lockup at Assabet, to do or act as
the town shall think best
