

Art 3^d To see if the Town will choose a committee to meet the County Commissioners on the Petition of Arnold Farn and others

4th To see if the Town will authorize the Overseers of the Poor to heat the house on the Town Farm by putting in a furnace, to do or act as the town shall think best.

5th To see if the Town will reconsider the vote passed on the twenty-second day of July last granting thirty thousand dollars in aid of the Lowell and Framingham Rail Road.

6th To hear and act on reports

7th To see if the Town will authorize the Overseers of the Poor, to hire a warden on the Poor Farm for a term of years, to do or act in relation to a warden on the Town Farm as the town shall think best.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting an attested copy thereof at the Town House, at each of the public Meeting Houses, and at the Post Office in the Village of Assabet, in said town, two sabbaths, at least, before the time appointed for holding said meeting.

Cereof fail not and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon to the town clerk, at or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
