In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify the Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the Town Hall in said Town on Monday the Twentieth day of February current at two of the Clock in the afternoon then and there to act on the following articles viz:

Art 1st To Choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting

" 2^d To see if the Town will give any further instructions to their committee chosen to oppose the incorporation of any part of their Territory into another Town.

" 3^d To see if the Town will dispose of the old Punting School-house and Furniture - to do or act as the town shall think best.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting an attested copy thereof at the Town House, at each of the Public Meeting Houses and at the Post office in the Village of Assabetz two Sabbaths at least before the time of said meeting - Hereof fail not and make return of this Warrant to the Town Clerk at or before the time of Meeting aforesaid.
