

Art 5 Voted that the taxes for the current year, be made payable and collected as follows. Viz:  
 All single Poll Taxes payable on demand;  
 All other Taxes assessed upon the inhabitants of the of the Town payable in two equal installments, the first on the first day of September and the second on the first day of December, and all Taxes assessed against non-residents including Highway Taxes shall be payable in full on the first day of September.

Voted that the offices of Town Treasurer & Collector of Taxes, be let out to the lowest bidder, that the sum for which it is bid off shall be payment in full for the performance of all the duties of both offices, which are required by law or by vote of the town.

And the same was then let out to Samuel A. Jones for the sum of ninetyeight dollars.
