In the name of the Commonwealth of Massa-
chusetts, you are hereby required to notify and
warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury,
qualified to vote in town affairs, to meet at
the Town Hall, in said town, on Monday the
3^d day of April next, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon
then and there to act on the following arti-
cles Viz.

- Art. 1st To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.
- Art. 2^d To choose all necessary Town Officers, not chosen
at March meeting for the year ensuing.
- Art. 3^d To grant money for Schools and apportion the
same; to do or act &c.
- Art. 4. To grant money for the support of Poor the
present year
- Art. 5. To grant money to pay interest on the Town Debt
and Railroad Stock; to do or act &c
- Art. 6. To determine the manner of repairing Highways
Town ways and Bridges the coming year, and
grant money for the same.
- Art. 7. To see if the Town will take any action relative
to Town lines between Sudbury and Wayland;
to do or act &c
- Art. 8. To hear and act on reports.
- Art. 9. To see if the Town will take any action relative
to the use and care of the Town Hall; to do or act &c.
- Art. 10 To grant money to pay the interest on the "Jerusha
Howe Fund"
