

Apr 22, To see if the Town will take any stock in the Massachusetts Central Railroad: to do or act, &c.

Apr 23, To see if the Town will grant money to pay for enlarging the Poor Farm Barn, and all other necessary money, to meet the Town expenses the present year.

Apr 24 To see if the Town will choose a committee or Committees to make the distribution of the interest arising from the several funds in Town.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting an attested copy thereof at the Town House, at each of the public Meeting Houses, and at the Post Office in the Village of Assabet, in said Town, two Sabbaths, at least, before the time appointed for holding said meeting.

Whereof fail not and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
