

Apr 4 Voted to appropriate the sum of Eight hundred, and forty eight \$400 Dollars, received from the sale of wood and lumber from the Poor Farm, and now in the Treasury, for the support of Poor the present year.

Apr 5 Voted to grant the sum of Two Thousand Five hundred Dollars to pay interest on the Town Debt and on money borrowed to pay for stock in the Frammingham & Lowell Rail Road.

Apr 6 Voted to grant Twelve hundred Dollars, for the purpose of repairing Highways Town ways and Bridges the present year

Apr 8 Report of School Committee read and accepted. School Committee instructed to number the School Districts and School Houses.

Verbal Report of the Committee on the setting off of the Town of "Maynard" accepted.

Under consideration of the report of the Committee on the "Dr Stearns Papers," the Town voted to authorize the Town Clerk to examine certain genealogical records among said papers, and to copy so much of the same upon the Town Record as he shall think proper.

Apr 16 Voted To grant One Thousand Dollars for incidental expenses the present year.
