

- Art 19 Voted to reconsider the vote whereby the report of the Selectmen concerning the widening of the road near the house of Richard Dwyer was accepted
- Art 21 Report of the board of Highway Surveyors concerning the discontinuance of a piece of highway near Sandham Schoolhouse read accepted and adopted.
- Art 23 Granted Five Hundred Dollars to pay for enlarging the Poor Farm Barn.
 Granted Eight Hundred Dollars to pay for making road and bridge near Willis Mills.
 Granted Three Hundred Dollars to pay expenses of Law suit on account of Thomas Pierce
- Art 14 Voted that hereafter all notes of the Town shall be signed by the Treasurer and countersigned by the chairman or acting chairman of the Selectmen, and that no money shall be paid from the Town Treasury without a written order from the Selectmen
 Voted also that the Town Treasurer be required to furnish to the Selectmen a list of all persons holding notes against the Town with the amount and date of each one's claim and the time to which interest is paid; and that hereafter the Selectmen shall be required to keep a list of all the liabilities of the town and a record of the time to which the interest upon each claim is paid.
 Voted also that whenever in the future a motion is made to authorize the Treasurer to borrow money, it shall be the duty of the Town Clerk to suggest that the following proviso be appended thereto, to wit: "Provided that the note or notes given therefor shall be countersigned by the Chairman or acting chairman of the Selectmen"
