At a Legal Town Meeting held at Sudbury May 2^d 1871. The Articles in the above Warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows viz

Art 1st Chose James Moore Esq. Moderator

" 2^d The Town by a vote of fifty seven yeas to thirty nays voted to prohibit the sale of Ale. Porter. Strong Beer or Lager Beer in said Town

3^d Voted to grant Thirty Dollars ^{to pay} for ringing the Bell the present year.

Art 4 Voted that the committee chosen by the Town on the twenty third day of January last consisting of Messrs Thomas A. Kurlbut. Charles
