

Widdlesex ss. Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

To James L. Willis or any Constable of the Town of Sudbury, in said County Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said town on Monday the 22^d day of May current at 2 o'clock P.M. then and there to act on the following articles viz:

- Art 1st To choose a Moderator to preside over said meeting.
- Art 2^d To see if the town will take any stock in the Massachusetts Central Railroad: do or act.
- Art 3^d To see if the town will choose some person to act as agent for the town in affairs relating to the Framingham and Lowell Railroad: do or act.
- Art 4th To see if the town will grant the sum of thirty dollars, in addition to that already granted to pay for ringing the bell at nine o'clock P.M. for the year ensuing.
- Art 5th To see if the town will authorize the town treasurer to borrow money to pay notes and accounts that may become due.
- Art 6th To see if the town will grant money for a new hay scale, to be placed ~~in the~~ near the centre of the town.
- Art 7th To see if the town will build a new schoolhouse in the west part of the town near the house of John Connelley.
- Art 8th To see if the town will remove the schoolhouse in the Centre District to some location on the Berlin Road, so called, near the house of George Goodnow: do or act.
- Art 9th To see if the town will rescind the vote passed at their last meeting held May 2^d whereby they voted to not sell ale, porter, or lager beer: do or act.
- Art 10th To see if the town will rescind the vote whereby they voted thirty dollars to ring the bell, at the last meeting: do or act.
