At a Legal Town Meeting holden at Sndbury Pursuant to the above Warrant the Articles of said Warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows Viz

Art 1 Chose James Moore, Moderator,

Art 2 Voted to Choose a Committee of five to meet the County Commissioners on Monday next Sept. 11.th and Mebers Thomas P. Kenilburt, James Moore, J. M. Jones S. B. Rogers & John A. Maynard were chosen for said Committee

Then Voted that the Selectmen be Added to this Committee, and by further vote said Committee was instructed to oppose the laying out of the proposed new road. — the above vote being counted the result was one hundred and two voted in the affirmative and three in the negative
