

- Art. 1. To choose a Moderator to preside at said Meeting
- Art. 2^d To see if the Town will take any measures to repair the road leading from the Centre of the Town to the house of George Moore, to do or act as the Town shall think best
- Art. 3^d To see if the Town will accept of a private way as laid out by the Selectmen on petition of Curtis B Moore, to do or act as the town shall think best, and appropriate money to meet the expense.
- Art. 4. To see if the town will grant or appropriate any money for the support of a public Singing School, to do or act on the subject of a Singing School as the town may think best.
- Art. 5. To see if the town will take any action relative to a notice of petition by the Selectmen of the Town of Maynard, to be presented to the next General Court, praying for an alteration or amendment to the Act of Incorporation of said Town of Maynard, to do or act &c.
- Art 6 To see if the town will appropriate any money to pay for building the new Schoolhouse in the westerly part of the Town.
- Art. 7. To see if the town will provide ladders, hooks or any other articles to be used in extinguishing fires, to do or act as the town shall think best.
- Art 8 To hear and act on reports
- Art. 9. To see if the town will give the free use of the Town House for all Meetings called to aid the sufferers by the recent fires at the West
