In the name of the Commonwealth of Massa-
chusetts, you are hereby required to notify and
warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury
qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet at the
Town Hall in said Town on Monday the 4th
day of March next at ten o'clock in the
forenoon then and there to act on the following
Articles: viz

- Art 1 To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting
- " 2 To choose all necessary Town officers for the year
ensuing
- " 3 To determine the manner of repairing Highways
Townways and bridges the coming year and
grant money for the same
- " 4 To hear and act on reports of Committees
- " 5 To see if the Town will choose a committee to
let out the repairing of the road from or near
the Town House to George Moore's house to do
or act as the Town thinks best and grant
money for the same
- " 6 To hear and act on reports,
- " 7 To see if the Town will purchase Hay scales
to be located near the Centre of the Town.
- " 8 To see if the Town will remove, repair or
refurnish the school house in the Centre
of the Town, to do or act in reference to said
school house or school as the Town thinks best.
- " 9 To see if the Town will have the receipts and Expenditures
of the Town for the year 1871 printed.
