The following Report of Committee was then read accepted and ordered to be recorded. viz:

"The Committee chosen to number the School Districts in Town have attended to that duty and report as follows:

Plates were procured, lettered + numbered at a cost of \$7.50 which were assigned in the following order:

Commencing with the Centre district, which we designated as No. 1. The Committee next proceeded to the house in the S. W. District, (formerly so called) which they numbered 2. Thence passing to the right of the Center of the Town, the remaining houses were numbered in their regular order, closing with the new house near the residence of John Coughlin which we numbered 6.
