"The Undersigned having been appointed the Agent of the Town of Sudbury to Superintend the enlargement of the barn on the Town Farm, has attended to that duty and reports the expense thereof as follows, viz:

Paid for labor including digging cellar, taking down and relaying cellar wall Mason work and Carpenter work \$324.65

Paid for Materials, including Lumber,

Lime nails & hardware ————— 238.59

Total \$563.24

To pay which the Town granted 50000

Leaving a balance of expense of 63.24

Which amount has been received of the Selectmen

A portion of the whole expense as reported was applied to necessary repairs on the old part of the barn, which if reckoned separately would amount to more than the balance above the grant.
