

only angle in said line near the Iron Works Causeway which will also answer the purpose of a guide board which guideboard is to be kept in repair by the town of Sudbury; we have also erected stone monuments marked S. & M. at such places as said line crosses the highways.

Subsequently to this settlement and after the town of Sudbury had fulfilled all the obligations imposed upon them by said act the Selectmen of the town of Maynard petitioned the legislature for an amendment of their Charter to relieve them from a fulfillment of their obligations to the town of Sudbury.

At a legal town meeting called for that purpose your committee were instructed to oppose said petition before the Committee of the Legislature. We have attended to that duty and have the pleasure to report that immediately after the hearing was through, the committee before whom it was had decided unanimously to report recommending that the petitioners have leave to withdraw, and their report was unanimously accepted by the legislature.
