

Art 5 Voted that Messrs J. P. Fairbanks, F. F. Walker and N. L. Pratt be a committee in connection with the School Committee to paint, repair and refurnish the school house in the Centre District. Said committee were further instructed to investigate the other matter referred to in this article and act according to their discretion.

Art 6 Voted to authorize the Treasurer to borrow money to pay notes that may be called for and for other necessary purposes.

Art 7 Voted to accept the following "List of Jurors" viz Geo. M. Barton, Edward E. Brown, John M. Conant, Luther S. Cutting, John H. Dakin, Edwin A. Garry, Dana W. Hayden, Richard R. Koss, Luther E. Hamt, Levi S. Jones, Dexter C. Jones, William P. Jones, Moses W. Maynard, Nathan L. Pratt, James J. Puffer, Edwin Rogers, Lorenzo Parmenter, George Parmenter, Nathan Goodnow, George Goodnow, Elbert Gooding.

Art 8 Voted that the Taxes be payable and collected in the same manner as last year.

Voted also that the business of Town Treasurer and Collector of Taxes be let out to the lowest bidder on the same conditions as for the year 1871, and the same was taken by Jonas S. Hunt for the sum of twenty Dollars.

Art 9 Voted that Town Meetings for the ensuing year be called by causing warrants to be posted at the Town House and at each of the public Meeting houses, two Sabbaths at least before the time of Meeting.

Art 10 Voted that the matter referred to in this Article be left to the selectmen.

Art 11 Voted to pass over this Article.
