

- Art 12 Voted to instruct the Selectmen to notify the County commissioners, immediately, of the condition of the road referred to in this Article, and also other roads in town which are intersected by the Framingham and Lowell Railroad, which are not in proper condition and request that defects may be remedied.
- Art 13 Voted to grant Three Hundred Dollars for improvements upon the road from Sudbury Centre to South Sudbury, the said sum to be expended under the direction of the Selectmen
- Art 14 Voted that the income of funds for the benefit of the poor be distributed by the Overseers of the Poor; and for the benefit of schools by the School Committee
- Art 15 Voted to grant Fifty Dollars for the purpose named in this Article, and the Selectmen were instructed to require from the person or persons to which said money is paid, a statement of the purpose for which it is used
- Art 16 No action upon this Article
- Art 17 The Town by a vote of 75 in the affirmative to 21 in the negative. Voted to oppose the granting of the petition of James S. Draper and others, and Messrs James Moore, J. S. Hunt, John B Goodnow, Isaac M Jones, Abel B. Jones and Edward E Brown were chosen a Committee to appear before the County commissioners for that purpose, and said Committee was instructed by the Town, in the event of the prayer of the petitioners being granted to appeal to the Supreme Court for an injunction
