To John Goodnow, a Constable of the
Town of Sudbury in said County, Greeting;

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in Elections, to meet at the Town Hall in said town, on Tuesday the fifth day of November next, it being the Tuesday next after the first Monday of said Month, to bring in to the Selectmen their votes for thirteen Electors of President and Vice President of the United States, and a Representative in the next Congress of the United States for District No. 7: also, for a Representative to fill the vacancy in the present Congress in District No. 7: for a Governor Lieutenant Governor, Secretary, Treasurer and Receiver General, Auditor, and Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts; for a Councillor for District No. 6. and a Senator for Middlesex Senatorial District No. 5. and for a County Commissioner for Middlesex County, all on one ballot.

Also, to bring in their votes for a Representative to the next General Court of Massachusetts for Middlesex Representative District No. 19, upon a separate ballot; both the foregoing ballots to be deposited at one checking.

Balls to be opened at 10 o'clock A.M. and may be closed at 2 o'clock P.M.

And you are also required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs, to assemble at the Town Hall in said town on Tuesday the fifth day of November next
