

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held at the Town Hall in said town on Tuesday Nov. 5th 1872. the Articles in the foregoing Warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows to wit.

Art 1st Chose James Moore Moderator. who was not present; and then chose Thomas P. Hurlbut Moderator pro Tem.

Art 2 The School Committee made a verbal report to the Town concerning School District No. 6. and the town voted to accept and adopt a vote previously passed by the School Committee which was as follows, viz:

"Voted, that all children attending school who reside beyond the house of George W. Willis, including those from the town farm - and all west of the house of Asa M Durrel, shall attend the school in District No. 6."

Art 3 Voted to give the free use of the Town Hall for a Singing School and Lyceum.

Art 4 Voted that the Treasurer be ordered to pay to the town of Maynard such part of the state school fund as shall in the judgement of the School Committee seem just and proper

Voted also to appropriate a sum of money sufficient to pay the expenses of the winter school in District No. 6.

Art 5 Voted to pass over this Article

Art 6 Voted to leave the matter of this article to the Selectmen giving them power to require the widening of the road if they shall think necessary
