To John Crockett a Constable of the
Town of Sudbury in said County, Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at their Town Hall, on Monday, the Third day of March, next, at ten o'clock A.M. then and there to act on the following articles, Viz:

- Art 1 To choose a Moderator to preside at said Meeting
- Art 2 To choose all necessary Town Officers for the ensuing year
- Art 3 To hear and act on reports
- Art 4 To determine the manner of repairing highways, townways and bridges the ensuing year
- Art 5 To see if the town will pay a bill presented by M. Glazier of Saxonville, for damages alleged to have been caused by a defect in the highway.
- Art 6 To see if the town will except of the provisions of Chap. 158 of the acts of the year 1871
- Art 7 To see if the town will make any alteration in the dividing line between school districts No. 1. and No. 6; to do or act in reference to school districts as the town shall deem best.
- Art 8 To see if the town will order a new valuation of the real estate by the Assessors.
