Middlesex S.S.To John Woodruff, Constable of the Town
of Sudbury, in said County. Meeting;

In the name of the Commonwealth of
Massachusetts you are hereby required
to notify and warn the inhabitants
of the Town of Sudbury, qualified to
vote in town affairs, to meet at their
Town Hall, on Monday the seventh day
of April next, at 10 o'clock A. M.
then and there to act on the follow-
ing articles, viz:

- Art. 1. To choose a Moderator to preside in
said meeting.
- Art. 2. To choose any necessary town officers
not chosen at March meeting and
also to fill any vacancies occasioned
by non-acceptance or otherwise.
- Art. 3. To grant money for all necessary town purposes.
- Art. 4. To hear and act on reports.
- Art. 5. To see if the Town will accept of a list of
jurors as prepared by the Selectmen.
- Art. 6. To see if the Town will grant money to
widen and repair the road and build a
culvert near the house of W^m Baighem.
- Art. 7. To see if the Town will grant money for
building a culvert across the road near
the house of Homer Rogers.
- Art. 8. To see if the Town will support a High
School in the center of the Town.
- Art. 9. To see if the Town will grant money to
the G. A. R. Post. 86 to pay Expenses on Dec-
oration day.
- Art. 10. To decide in regard to use and care of
Town Hall for the coming year.
- Art. 11. To see if the Town will authorize the Treasurer
to borrow money to pay notes that may be called
for, and bills that may be presented before
