

- Art 6 Voted to leave the matter referred to in this article to the Selectmen, with instructions to cause such repairs as they think necessary to be made at the expense of the town, provided such repairs are not made by the Rail Road Company.
- Art 7 Voted to leave this matter with the Road Commissioners
- Art 8 Voted to instruct the School Committee to employ a male Teacher for the winter term of the Upper School in the Centre District, and that said school be open for advanced scholars from all parts of the town
- Art 9 Voted to grant the sum of fifty dollars
- Art 10 Voted, that the Town House be used and cared for according to regulations adopted by the town Apr. 5th 1869.
- Art 11 Voted to Authorize &c.
- Art 12 Voted that the taxes be made payable and collected in the same manner as last year, & that business of Collector and Treasurer be done by the same person and that the same be let out to the lowest bidder - then let out said business to Jones S. Hunt for the sum of fifteen Dollars
- Art 13 Voted to leave this matter with the Road Commissioners, with instructions to purchase gravel wherever they think it advisable.
- Art 14 Voted that Town Meetings for the ensuing year, be warned by causing warrants for the same to be posted at the Town House at each of the public Meeting houses and at each Post Office in South Sudbury and North Sudbury, to Sabbath before each meeting
