To John Goodnow, a Constable of the
Town of Sudbury in said County Greeting;

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, qualified to vote in Elections, to meet in their Town Hall in said town, on Tuesday, the fourth day of November next, it being the Tuesday next after the first Monday of said month, to bring in to the Selectmen their votes for a Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary, Treasurer and Receiver General, Auditor, and Attorney-General of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, a Councillor for District No. 6, and a Senator for the fifth Middlesex Senatorial District; a County Commissioner, County Treasurer, Register of Probate and Insolvency for Middlesex County, and a Register of Deeds for the Southern District of said County, all upon one ballot.

Also to bring in their votes for a Representative to the next General Court of Massachusetts for Middlesex Representative District No. 19, upon a separate ballot; both the foregoing ballots to be deposited at one checking

Polls to be opened at 10 o'clock A.M. and may be closed at 2 o'clock P.M.

And you are also required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the Town Hall in said Town on Tuesday the fourth day of November next at 1 o'clock in the afternoon there and there to act on the following Articles, Viz,
