

Art 1st To choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting.

Art 2. To see if the Town will instruct their Selectmen to so draw their warrant for the annual March meeting as to require the voters to bring in their votes for such Town officers as are required to be chosen by ballot, all upon one ticket, to do or act as the town shall deem best

Art 3 To see if the town will take measures to petition the County Commissioners to lay out a road near the house of William Brigham, to do or act in regard to said as the town shall judge best.

Art 4 To see if the town will instruct the Assessors to print their report

Art 5 To hear and act on reports

Art 6 To see if the town will refund any taxes paid by Nathan L. Preitt, and Milton Brooks

Art 7 To see if the town will authorize the Overseers of the Poor to sell any of the wood on the Poor Farm.

Art 8 To see if the town will appropriate any of the unappropriated money in the treasury

Art 9 To see if the town will purchase a New Hears

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting attested copies thereof at the Town House, at each of the public Meeting Houses and at each of the Post Offices in said Town two Sabbaths at least before the time of said meeting

Whereof fail not and make return of this Warrant with your doings thereon, to ourselves at or before the time of meeting aforesaid
