To John Goodnow, Constable of the Town of Sudbury in said County - Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town qualified to vote in town affairs, to meet at their Town House on Monday the Second Day of March next at ten o'clock in the forenoon, then and there to act on the following articles viz:

- Art 1 To choose a Moderator to preside in said Meeting
- Art 2 To choose all necessary Town officers for the ensuing year
- Art 3 To hear and act on reports
- Art 4 To see if the Town will maintain a High School during all, or any portion of the coming year
- Art 5 To see if the Town will make any changes in the bylaws regulating the Goodnow Library, so as to better accommodate the people of the Town
- Art 6 To see if the Town will revoke its acceptance of the provisions of Chap. 158. of the acts of the year 1871, and abolish its Board of Road Commissioners.
- Art 7 To determine the manner of repairing its Highways Townways and bridges and grant money for the same for the coming year
- Art 8 To see if the Town will take any measures to provide additional school accommodations for District No. 3.
