order upon said petition, and act
as they shall judge to be for the
interest of the Town

Reports of the Overseers of the Poor, of the
Receipts and Expenditures of the Town
Farm - Concerning the Inmates,
concerning the Distribution of the
wood paid for by the income of the
"Jemsha Howe Fund," and the Distri-
bution of the Interest of the "Elisha Good-
now Fund" for the benefit of the indus-
trious Poor, read and accepted.
Voted to instruct the Overseers to cut wood
from the Town farm to balance the
interest of the Jemsha Howe Fund

Article till "April Meeting"

Art. 6. The Town Voted to revoke its acceptance
of the provisions of Chap. 158. of the Acts of
the year 1871, and abolish its Board of
Road Commissioners
