In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of said Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet at their Town Hall, on Monday, the third day of April next, at Ten o'clock A.M. Then and there to act on the following articles, Viz:

- Art 1 To choose a Moderator to preside in said Meeting
- Art 2 To fill any vacancies in Town Offices occasioned by non acceptance or otherwise
- Art 3 To hear and act on reports.
- Art 4 To grant money for all necessary Town Purposes
- Art 5 To grant money to be expended in the observance of decoration day.
- Art 7. To see if the Town will give authority to the Treasurer to borrow money to pay notes that may be called for, and for other purposes.
- Art 8 To see if the Town will accept a list of jurors prepared by the Selectmen.
- Art 9 To determine the manner of calling Town meetings the present year.
- Art 10 To determine the manner of collecting Taxes the present year, and agree with some suitable person to collect the same
- Art 11 To decide for what purposes and on what conditions the Town Hall may be used the present year and provide for taking care of the same
