

- AR 14 Voted to instruct the selectmen to purchase or procure by due process of law, such gravel pits as may be needed
- AR 15 Voted to grant One Thousand Dollars for special repairs on highways and bridges - the Selectmen to superintend the expenditure of the same
- AR 16 Voted that One Hundred dollars be paid to Mr. T. J. Sanderson when he shall have completed the work referred to in this article to the acceptance of the Selectmen
- AR 17 Voted that all Town officers shall receive two dollars and fifty cents per day, and no more, for doing business in town,
Voted to instruct the Assessors to divide the town and take the valuation separately
- AR 19 Voted to instruct the Selectmen to print the report of receipts and expenditures for the present year, including reports of the School Committee and "Goodnow Library Committee"
- AR 18 Voted to appropriate any unappropriated money in the Treasury for the payment of bills that may become due before taxes are collected
- AR 20 Voted to instruct the Overseers of the Poor to set off a piece of the Town farm for a gravel pit
