

- Art 2 Voted the Selectmen chosen at this meeting. be the board of Fence Viewers for the ensuing year.
- Voted also that the Selectmen be instructed to appoint three field drivers - a Pound Keeper and a sealer of weights and measures.
- Art 3 No Reports read. and this article was put over till April Meeting
- Art 4 Voted to grant the sum of Twelve Hundred dollars for repairs of Highways Townways and Bridges the ensuing year. that one half the above sum be worked out before the first day of July, and if not worked out at that time, the Selectmen be required to work out the balance.
- Voted to choose a surveyor for each of the several wards and that the money granted be apportioned to said Surveyors by the Selectmen.
- Voted also that the pay of said Surveyors shall be Twenty cents per hour for their own services, and that the price of labor of men and teams be left to the Surveyors to hire as best they can, and that they be required to report the price paid.
- Then chose the persons whose names are recorded under Article 2 of this warrant for Highway Surveyors.
- Art 5 Voted that the matter referred to in this Article be left to the Selectmen, to act as they shall judge to be for the best interest of the Town.
- Art 6 Referred to the Selectmen.
- Art 7 Voted to grant the free use of the Town Hall for the purpose referred to in this Article.
- Art 8 Referred to the Selectmen.
