- Art 12 To see if the town will grant money for the special repairs of highways and choose committees to expend the same
- Art 13 To see if the town will take measures to improve the road leading to the new Cemetery
- Art 14 To see if the town will discontinue the road leading from the main road near Abel Willis' to the David Howe place

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting attested copies of the same at the Town House at each of the Public Meeting Houses at each of the Post Offices, and at each Railroad Station in said town two Sabbaths before the time of said meeting

Whereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk, at the meeting aforesaid
