- Art 2^d Voted to authorize the Selectmen to act as they
shall think best, with reference to a method
of egress from the Town Hall at the northerly end
of said Hall
- Art 3 The following Reports were read and accepted
viz Of the Selectmen on the new Road on "Peakham"
so called - On the Case of B.C. Witherell -
On Repairs of School House No. 3.
- Art 4 Report of Laying out of Town Way referred to
in this Article Read and Accepted
- Art 5 Voted to authorize the Selectmen to remove
the Safe to the lower part of the Town House.
- Art 6 Voted to instruct the Selectmen to cause the
receipts and Expenditures of the Town to be
printed for the year ending March 1, 1878.
- Art 7 Voted to pass over this article
- Art 8 Voted that the several Schools in town be fur-
nished with wood cut from the Poor Farm
and prepared for the fire

Then Voted to dissolve this Meeting
