To James & Willis, a Constable of the Town
of Sudbury in said County; Meeting:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet at the Town Hall in said Town on Monday, the first day of April next at ten o'clock A.M. then and there to act on the following Articles, Viz

- Art. 1. To choose a Moderator to preside in said Meeting
- Art. 2. To fill any vacancies in Town Offices occasioned by non-acceptance or otherwise
- Art. 3. To hear and act on reports
- Art 4 To grant money for all necessary town purposes
- Art 5 To determine the manner of calling Town Meetings the present year
- Art 6 To see if the town will accept of a list of Jurors prepared by the Selectmen
- Art 7 To determine the manner of Collecting Taxes the present year and agree with some suitable person to collect the same
- Art 8 To see if the town will give authority to the Treasurer to borrow money to pay notes that may be presented for payment, and for other necessary purposes
- Art 9 To decide for what purposes, and on what conditions the Town Hall may be used the present year and provide for taking care of the same
