Art 7 Voted that the Taxes be made payable and collected in two equal installments - the first on the first on the first day of September ~~the~~ second on the first day of December. That all single Poll Taxes be made payable on demand - That the collector be authorized and required to collect interest at the rate of six percent per annum on all taxes not paid within ten days of the above dates - the interest so collected to ^{be} paid into the town treasury -

Then Voted to let out the business of Treasurer and Collector of Taxes to the lowest bidder and the same was let out to Samuel B. Rogers for the sum of Seventy dollars. said sum to be payment in full for all services ^{and duties} of both said offices

Art 8 Voted to Authorize the Treasurer to borrow money as proposed in this article.

Art 9 Voted that the Town Clerk and Selectmen be instructed
