To James & Willis a Constable of
the Town of Sudbury in said County. Greeting
In the name of the Commonwealth of Massa-
chusetts you are directed to notify the in-
habitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified
to vote in elections and Town affairs to meet
at the Town Hall in said Town, on Monday
the first day of March next at ten o'clock
in the forenoon then and there to act
on the following Articles Viz:

- Art. 1. To choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting
Art. 2. To choose all necessary Town officers for the
year ensuing
Art. 3. To hear and act on reports
Art. 4. To determine the manner of repairing highways
Town ways and bridges the coming year
and grant money for the same

And you are directed to serve this Warrant
by posting attested copies hereof at the Town
House at each of the public Meeting Houses
at each Post Office and at each of the
railroad Stations in said Town, Two Sab-
baths at least before the time of said meet-
ing.

Heretofore not and make due return of
this Warrant with your doing thereon
to the Town Clerk at the Time and Place
of meeting aforesaid.
