Town of Sudbury in said County Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Mass.
achusetts, you are directed to notify the In-
habitants of the Town of Sudbury, qualified to
vote in elections and Town affairs to meet
at the Town Hall, in said Sudbury on Mon-
day, the fifth day of April next at ten o'clock
in the forenoon then and there to act on the
following Articles Viz:

- Art. 1. To choose a Moderator to preside at said Meeting
- Art. 2. To fill any vacancies that may exist in Town
offices, caused by non acceptance or otherwise
- Art. 3. To grant money for all necessary Town purposes
- Art. 4. To determine the manner of collecting Taxes for
the ensuing year, and to provide for collecting
the same
- Art. 5. To act on the list of Jurors prepared by the Selectmen
- Art. 6. To see if the town will order printed reports of the
receipts and expenditures for the ensuing year
to do or act as the town may think best
- Art. 7. To provide for the distribution of the income
of funds
- Art. 8. To determine for what purposes and upon what
conditions the Town Hall may be used the
ensuing year, and provide for taking care of
the same
- Art. 9. To hear and act on reports
- Art. 10. To see if the town will take measures to have their
Alms house painted the present year
