- Art. 11. Voted to authorize the Treasurer to borrow money, as may be necessary for the Towns use
- Art. 12. Voted to instruct the School committee to paint the school house in district No. 1. the present year, also to cause a ventilator to be put into said school house, and such repairs made as may be necessary
- Art. 13. Passed Over
- Art. 14. Voted that the matter referred to in this article be referred to the Selectmen with instructions to report at some future meeting
- Art 15 Voted to grant the sum of four hundred dollars to be expended in repairs upon the road named in this article, That the Selectmen be a committee to superintend said repairs, and that said committee be instructed to let out the same by contract
- Art 16 Voted to Abate the Tax of John M. Walkup for the year 1878
- Art 17 Voted to instruct the Assessors to take a general valuation of all the real and personal property in the town the present year, and cause a report of the same with the taxes assessed thereon, to be printed for distribution at the earliest possible time after said assessment, shall have been completed.
