- Art. 2. To see if the Town will build a School-house in the South part of the town, and appropriate or authorize the Treasurer to borrow money for that purpose, the location of such building to be west of the so-called Sandham Brook, to do or act relative to the several schools as the town may think best
- Art. 3. To see if the Town will appropriate money for the Singing School.
- Art. 4. To see if the town will give the free use of the Town Hall for the Singing School
- Art. 5. To see if the town will give the free use of the Town Hall for the monthly meetings of the Band of Hope the present year
- Art. 6. To see if the Town will give the free use of the Hall for the Band
- Art. 7. To see if the town will appropriate a sum of money to be expended on the road leading by J. C. Dakin's between the Boston road and Concord line

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up attested copies thereof at the Town House, at each of the public Meeting-houses, at each post office and at each railroad station in said town, two Sabbaths, at least, before the time for holding the meeting

Whereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at or before the time and place of meeting as aforesaid
