Art. 4 Report of Overseers of the poor

This report showed that the Total amount expended for support and assistance of the poor for the year ending March 1. 1881. was \$2402.35 = The amount of Receipts for the same time was \$2025.11 leaving a deficiency or balance against the town \$377.24

Art. 5. A partial, verbal report upon the matter referred to in this article, was made by Mr L. F. Gerry a member of the School Committee and further consideration of the subject was deferred until a detailed report shall have been made at "April Meeting"

Art. 6. Voted that the Selectmen be a committee of the town of Sudbury, to confer with a committee of the town of Wayland, concerning the boundary lines between said towns, and said committee is authorized, to enter into, and complete any agreement or plan by which said boundary lines may be straightened, without referring the same to the town
