At a Legal Town Meeting held at Sudbury April 14th A.D. 1881 the Articles in the above Warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows. Viz

Art. 1. Chose James Moore Esq Moderator

Art. 2. Chose Thomas P. Whitcomb for Surveyor and of Lumber and Measure of Wood, and Chose Andrew J. Parmenter Town Treasurer and Collector of Taxes.

Art. 3. Voted that the Taxes for the present year be made payable and collected as follows, Viz:
All single Poll Taxes payable on demand.
All Taxes of Nonresidents payable in full on the first day of September next, and all other Taxes in two equal installments.
