- Art 11 by inserting after the words "Three Trustees", the following words. "who shall be residents of the town of Sudbury".
Voted also to add the w said By-laws the following Article, to be numbered Eleven. "Each and every inhabitant of the town of Sudbury, of Twenty one years of age and upwards, shall have the privilege of choosing his or her quota of the books annually added to the Library, such choice to be signified to the board of Trustees who shall decide upon the admission or rejection of such book or books, and shall be obliged to give in case of rejection, written reasons therefor to the person so choosing"
- Art 12 Voted to instruct the Selectmen to print the receipts and expenditures &c as proposed in this Article
- Art. 13 No action taken upon this article
- Art. 14. Voted that the School Committee cause Schoolhouse No. 5 to be painted the present year
- Art. 15 Voted that J. S. Hunt be an agent of the town to procure and distribute School books to the School committee and Teachers, as called for
- Art. 16. No action taken upon this article
- Art. 17. Voted to direct the town Clerk to amend the record of March meeting concerning this matter
- Art. 18. Voted to refer this matter to the School Committee
- Art 19 Voted to refer this matter to the selectmen
- Art 20 Voted to refer this matter to the Selectmen
- Art 21 Voted to authorize the Treasurer to borrow money as proposed in this article
