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Commonwealth of Massachusetts

To any Constable of the Town of Sudbury
in said County Greeting:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
you are hereby required to notify and warn the in-
habitants of the town of Sudbury, qualified to vote
in elections, to meet at the Town Hall, in said
town on Tuesday the eighth day of November next
at ten o'clock in the forenoon. To bring in to
the Selectmen their votes for a Governor Lieut-
enant Governor, Secretary, Treasurer and Recei-
ver General, Auditor and Attorney General of
the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, a Council-
lor for District No. 6, one County Commissioner
and a Clerk of Courts for the County of Middlesex
and a Senator for Middlesex District No. 5;
all on one Ballot. Also to bring their votes
for a Representative to the next General Court
of Massachusetts, for Middlesex Representative
District No. 27, on a separate Ballot.

The Polls will Open at 10 o'clock A.M. and may
close at 2 o'clock P.M.

And you are further required to notify the
inhabitants of Sudbury qualified to vote in
town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in Sud-
bury on Tuesday the eighth day of November
next at 2 o'clock P.M. Then and there to act on
the following Articles, Viz:

- Art. 1. To choose a Moderator to preside in said Meeting.
- Art. 2 To hear and act on reports
- Art. 3. To see what action the town will take
in regard to the Stock the Town holds in the
Framingham and Lowell R.R. to do or act
in reference to said Subject as the Town may
judge best
