

- Art. 4. To see if the Town will accept the laying out of a Gravel Pit, by the Selectmen, on land of W & L. E. Perry, in the westerly part of the town
- Art. 5. To see if the Town will accept of a Legacy made to the town by Miss Emily Thompson, to do or act.
- Art. 6. To see if the town will accept of the laying out of a road by the Selectmen, on petition of Dexter C. Jones and others
- Art. 7. To see if the town will take any measures to have the straightening and widening, as laid out last year on the road near the estate of the late William Brigham, put in a condition for public use
- Art. 8. To see if the town will appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of having Singing taught in the public schools
- Art. 9. To see if the Town will refund the Tax on School House in District No. 7, assessed to Charles C. Parmenter, to do or act.

And you are required to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof at the Town House, at each of the public Meeting-houses, at each Post Office, and at each Railroad Station in said town, two Sabbaths at least before the time appointed for holding said Meeting

Hereof fail not, and make due return of this Warrant with your doings thereon, to ourselves, at or before the time and place of meeting aforesaid.
