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At a legal Town Meeting held at Sudbury April 3^d 1882 The Articles in the preceding Warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows-

Art. 1st Chose James Moore Esq Moderator

Art 2^d Chose Samuel Bent Assessor in place of Edward E. Brown resigned.

Chose Andrew J. Parmenter Treasurer and collector of Taxes

Voted that the Selectmen appoint additional Surveyors of Lumber and Measurers of wood if necessary.

Voted to instruct the Selectmen to cause all loose stones to be removed from the roads in Town in the months of April-

Art. 5 Voted that the taxes for the present year be made payable and collected as follows viz. All single poll Taxes payable on demand.
