

- Art. 12. To see if the town will choose a committee to take charge of building the bridge and road at South Sudbury, when ordered by the County Commissioners to do or act as the town may think best
- Art. 13. To see if the town will reduce its rate of interest on the Charity Funds
- Art. 14. To see if the town will order printed reports of the receipts and expenditures for the present year.
- Art. 15. To provide for the use and care of the Town House
- Art. 16. To vote on the question, "Shall License be granted for the sale of intoxicating liquors in this town the present year?"
- Art. 17. To provide for the distribution of the income of the Charity Funds
- Art. 18. To see if the town will cause any of its Schoolhouses to be painted the present year.
- Art. 19. To see if the town will authorize the Treasurer to borrow money for the use of the town if necessary.
- Art. 20. To see if the town will furnish a copy of the older records of Births, Marriages and Deaths to the New England Historic Genealogical Society
- Art. 21. To see if the town will enlarge its town Officers room

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof at the Town House, at each of the Public Meeting Houses, at each Post Office and at each Railroad Station in said town. Two Sabbaths at least, before the time of said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk, at or before the time of said meeting
