Art. 4. interest for the town, so long as there is not sufficient money in the treasury to meet all demands, and when there are sufficient funds in the Treasury to meet all demands, the Treasurer may use his discretion in the collection of interest as above provided

Then voted to consolidate the offices of Town Treasurer and Collector of taxes for the present year - that the compensation for the performance of all the duties of said offices be fixed at One Hundred and Twenty Dollars

Art. 5. Voted to make no change in the Bylaws of the "Goodnow Library"

Art 7 The Annual reports of the Selectmen on guide-posts and boards - The annual reports of the School Committee and the annual report of the Treasurer of the Goodnow Library - were accepted - A Verbal report of the Selectmen on the condition of the road near Mrs Catherine Conghlin's was made and the Selectmen ordered to appropriate fifty dollars out of the unexpended balance of the highway grant of the past year for repairs upon said road - A Verbal report was also made by the Selectmen relative to insurance of the School houses, and the town voted not to have them insured at present
