

- Art 8 Voted to pass over this Article
- Art 9 Voted to grant the sum of \$500. to be expended in repairs upon the road named in this article, and that the expenditure of the same be placed in the hands of the selectmen with instructions to let out the work by Contract to the lowest responsible Bidder
- Art 10 Voted to instruct the Selectmen to purchase one hundred chairs, to be kept in the Town house for the accommodation of the town and the schools in District No. one.
- Art 11 Voted to instruct the Selectmen to cause a well to be dug and a public watering place established near the School-house in District No. 3. and to make such provision as they think proper for public watering places at the Center of the town and at South Sudbury
- Art 12 Voted that the Selectmen be the committee for the purpose named in this article. That they be instructed to let out all the work required by the County Commissioners by contract, and to use any unappropriated money in the Treasury for the payment of the expense
- Art 13 Voted to pass over this Article
- Art 14 Voted to instruct the selectmen to cause a report of the receipts and expenditures of the present year to be printed for the use of the Town.
- Art 15 Voted that The Town House be used and cared for in the same manner and upon the same terms as last year
- Art 16 The Town by a unanimous vote decided not to vote upon the question referred to in this Article
- Art 17 Voted that the Assessors be instructed to distribute the income of the charity Funds.
