To James L. Willis, Constable of the Town of Sud-
bury in said County — Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
you are hereby required to notify and warn the in-
habitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote
in Elections to meet at the Town Hall in said Town
on Tuesday the sixth day of November next, it
being the "Tuesday next after the first Monday"
of said month, to bring in to the Selectmen their
Votes for a Governor, Lieutenant Governor,
Secretary-Treasurer and Receiver General,
Auditor, and Attorney General of the Com-
monwealth of Massachusetts; For a Councillor
for Councillor District No. 6; For a Senator
for Middlesex District No. 5. — For a Represen-
tative for Middlesex Representative District No. 27.
For a District Attorney for the term of three years,
Three commissioners of Insolvency for the term of
three years, a Register of Probate and Insolvency
for the term of five years, A Sheriff for the un-
expired term of the late Eben W. Fiske; and
a Sheriff for the term of three years from the
first Wednesday of January next, one County
Commissioner and two Special Commissioners
for the term of three years, all for the County of
Middlesex.

All the above votes to be brought in on one
ballot. Polls to be opened at ten o'clock ^{A.M.} and
may be closed at two o'clock P.M.

And you are also required to notify the
inhabitants of Sudbury, qualified to vote
in town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in
said town on Tuesday, the sixth day of
November next at one o'clock in the after-
noon, then and there to act on the following
Articles, viz:

Art. 1 To choose a Moderator to preside in said
meeting
