

- Art. 2. To see if the town will refund the amount of a Poll Tax paid by John E. Dwyer for the year 1882
- Art. 3. To hear and act on reports.
- Art. 4. To see if the Town will purchase a pair of horses for the Town Farm. To do or act. &c
- Art. 5. To see if the town will accept of the Laying out of a Town-Way by the Selectmen on petition of Lyman Parmenter, and others. to do or act in any way on the subject of said highway as the Town may think best.
- Art. 6. To see if the Town will pay Walter Rogers for gravel taken for widening road and bridge at South Sudbury.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof at the Town House, at each Post Office-Railroad Station and Public Meeting House in said Town, two Sabbaths at least before the time of holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not, and make due return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at or before said meeting.
